

Competitive Food Sales / Vending Machines

The sale of foods of minimal nutritional value, as defined by the U.S. Department of Agriculture Food and Nutrition Service, in competition with the school lunch program shall be prohibited from one-half hour before the first lunch period until one-half hour after the last lunch period.

Competitive food service is defined as any food or beverage service operated for profit by school-approved student organizations separate and apart from the non-profit federal / state reimbursed food service program. Student organizations shall include but not be limited to the student body as a whole, Future Homemakers of America, Future Farmers of America, band, and student council.

All sales shall be authorized by the principal prior to the commencement of the sale.

All areas accessible to students shall be governed by this policy.
