Student Activities (Co-curricular and Extra-curricular)

Possession and/or use of alcohol, drugs or tobacco will not be permitted at any time at any place under any conditions during the school year by participants in co-curricular and extra-curricular activities sponsored by the school. Any violation of this regulation will be cause for suspension, expulsion or ineligibility for any school-sponsored activity in addition to any sanctions that may be imposed for violation of Board policies concerning use of tobacco products, alcohol and drugs.

If a violation occurs, the case will be heard by the head coach of the season's sport or the activity's sponsor, the Activities Director and the Principal. The group will decide the severity of the case, and the principal will decide the appropriate action.
