The following policies were discussed in detail:

IKF - Graduation Requirements - This policy is being aligned with the state standard requirements. Colorado in 2010 evaluated proficiency and competency requirements for graduates; it was determined graduates weren't prepared for college and careers. 2013, adopted first draft of career/graduate readiness guidelines, minimum competencies. 2015, final draft adopted. Districts were charged with figuring out how to implement these minimum requirements. The goal is that students graduate college/career ready, whether that's in three years or five years. Pathways will be chosen in junior/senior year, freshman/sophomore is spent doing general type courses. New guidelines are hoping to be implemented next year with the incoming freshmen. The proposed changes will be posted on the website so parents can review the policy and provide their input. It will be finalized and adopted at a future board meeting before the start of next school year.

GDA-E21 - Dean of Students Job Description - The current job description lists hours. Hours, i.e., half time, full time, do no not need to be listed on the job description. Later in the board meeting the time will be approved by the board. The top line will be removed.

GDA-E10 - Asst. Principal/AD Job Description - Secondary is now 7th-12th. Changes are made to be more in line with what these positions are doing. Ms. Hufman wants to lead instruction, therefore her recommendation to remove instruction from Asst. Principal's job description. 3A, 6, 7C, 8L need to be changed or removed.

GDA-E11 - Secondary Principal Job Description - 32, change to "assist with discipline as needed."

ADD - Safe Schools - Discuss this with school counselors for further clarification before adoption in April.

ADD-E - Safe Schools Exhibit - Revised Exhibit No. 5 is not in the current policy, so they are going with the revised as is.

AE - Accountability - WISCAT is the district accountability committee; Ms. Hufman is in favor of having individual teams for the different schools because they have different needs.

AE-R - Accountability - Regulation - Terms were eliminated, giving people the opportunity to remain on the committees as long as they want because of low participation.
