

6th Annual Dolores Inquiring Minds Award

This scholarship will be awarded to a graduating Dolores High School Senior having a profound interest in biological science, math, or a physical science. The awardee should have economic need for the scholarship and intend to major in a biological science (i.e. biology, microbiology, genetics, plant science, etc.), math or a math related subject (i.e. statistics, etc.), or a physical science (i.e. chemistry, geology, physics etc.).

Applicants should have a minimum 3.25 GPA verified by transcripts indicating significant coursework in biological science, math, or a physical science (including courses taken by concurrent enrollment at local colleges).

The application will include:

- 1) A letter written by the applicant answering the questions below and can include any other relevant information the applicant would want to include.
- 2) Complete transcripts from DHS and if applicable, PCC, San Juan College, and Fort Lewis College.
- 3) Letters of recommendation.
- 4) A letter of acceptance/admittance to a 4 year college or university or confirmation of enrollment eligibility to a community college and intended enrollment date.

The complete application should submitted to the school principal.

An award of \$ 2,000 will be given to an individual successfully applying for the scholarship who has been accepted to a four year university. If the best applicants have been accepted at two-year colleges, two awards of \$ 1,000 each will be awarded.

Deadline for application is Monday May 4, 2020.

Application Questions:

- 1. What has inspired your interest in math, a physical science, or a biological science and why you intend to major in that discipline?
- 2. In your opinion, how are math and the sciences important to our society?
- 3. Please explain your financial need for this scholarship.
