Technology with Mr. Vega

All students in grades 1-6 continue to develop their keyboarding skills. Touch typing is our goal and we are working hard to have consistently good technique.

4th-grade is continuing to learn about online research. We have learned about crafting a search to return quality and relevant results. We have learned to use a critical eye when using unknown websites, online articles, and news reports. Now we are learning how to take notes and cite sources while researching in Google Docs.

5th and 6th-graders are problem solving and learning about the power of the screenshot. Students are learning to capture, annotate and use screenshots to support their writing. Students have been tasked with writing instructions to solve problems and will use screenshots to provide a visual.

3rd-grade is learning to create slideshow presentations using Google Slides. They are learning how to use bulleted lists and insert images to support their writing.

2nd-grade students are being introduced to Google Drawings.

1st-grade students are now using Google Classroom to share thoughts and ideas and also to access activities that I provide in the form of links.

Kindergarten continues to use Waterford to increase their reading, math, and science skills.
