Dear Dolores Families,

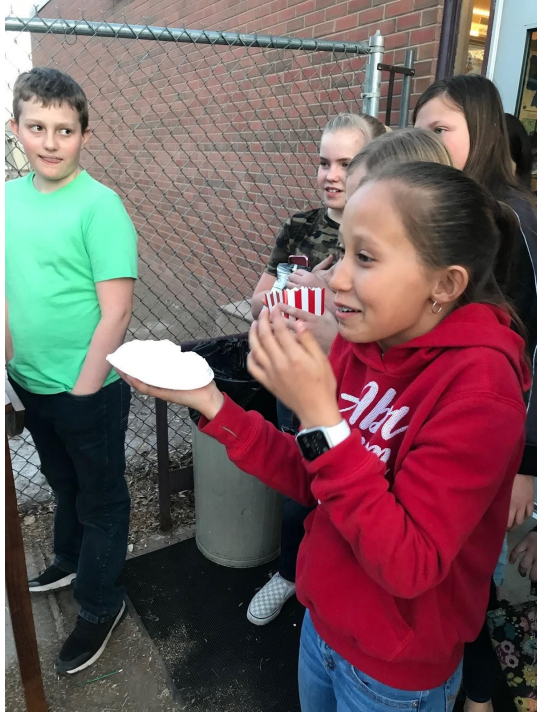

A note from: Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment.
