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An additional salary of \$500/week for Head Coaches and \$200 for Assistant Coaches will be paid for all CHSAA sponsored State Competitions (this does not include league or district competitions). This additional salary is also for High School Knowledge Bowl for state competitions.

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- Head Varsity Coaches at the High School level are encouraged to offer summer camps in their respective programs. Head Coaches who develop a summer camp program must meet with their building principal to seek approval for offering the camp.
- Each year Principals will be given a set amount of funding for stipends to be distributed to staff members that serve on committees, leadership teams, etc.
- > For multiple sponsors, the stipend will be equally distributed among the sponsors.
- > For teaching an approved Professional Development class, the District will pay \$20/hr. up to a maximum of 25 hours for the class
- At the Superintendent's discretion, the District will pay \$20/hr. up to a maximum of 25 hours for curriculum work.
