Infectious Disease Safety Protocols

- The most recent county data is used to determine cases within our community as well as vaccination rates.
- The school nurse checks local numbers weekly (Thursdays) on the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment website. https://covid19.colorado.gov/data/covid-19-dial-dashboard
- Active Cases are determined by a student that was positive while on campus. Active case numbers will roll off after 10 days.
- Campus designation + one other county descriptor will be used.
- These are campus-by-campus determinations.
