The meeting was called to order at 5:05 pm.

Secretary Minutes: Minutes from the September 13th, 2021 meeting were shared by Pam (October meeting was cancelled due to school going to remote learning). Student Council Report: No one was present to report.

New Business:

organization run concessions and the use of the shed. Discussion was held about
concessions and the lack of organizations signing up for concessions and if we should
open up concessions to outside organizations. Kim will draft an announcement to

go. We also discussed purchasing a small roaster to keep food warm during concessions. Pam made a motion "that we purchase a small roaster with the cost not to exceed \$50.00". Shelly seconded the motion. Motion passed.
