Kindness Fundraiser Feb. 7th: We will soon be sending home a flier explaining our upcoming kindness fundraiser. We will send hardcopies home at the start of the fundraiser on Feb. 7th, but we wanted you to have a heads up that it's coming! The kids will collect pledges for the number of acts of kindness they do. Good day parents,

I wanted to take a minute and go over some of the drop off and pick up zone issues that we are seeing.

I have attached a map below to go with this message. New signage has been placed on 12th street for the drop off and pick up lane. The drop off and pick up lane is for that specifically; dropping off or picking up, please do not park and exit your vehicle. IF traffic is moving then you will be moving up fairly quickly to pick up your student. Once you pick up your student you do not have to stay in the drop off or pick up lane, you can merge onto 12th street if it's clear to do so. Please make sure you are not pulling out infront of people.

If you need to speak with a staff member or another parent we are asking that you please find a place to park, either along the left hand side of 12th street or in the parking lot.

Parents who are parking down off of Central Avenue and 12th Street please speak with your student about stopping and looking both ways before they cross the street.

The intersection of 11th street and Central Avenue is usually extremely congested and busy. If you see traffic backing up on 11th street, please use an alternative route. Please do not block the intersection, this causes vehicles to have to go around you through an intersection and is extremely dangerous for other drivers.

I am working with the town to get 12th Street painted. Please be patient as we try to navigate drop off and pick up. As the weather gets bad please remember to give yourself enough time to travel and arrive at your destination safely.

Hello Little Bear Families!

January Guidance Lessons always will focus on relaxation skills. Kids simply cannot learn if they are stressed or worried. More critical is that they cannot think about what to do in an emergency if they are not able to calm themselves. Diaphragmatic breathing is always the fastest way to get calm. Then this year we will learn how to do deep muscle relaxation and, finally, Mindfulness. Your help is needed to help them practice. It's an easy way to get them calm and focused before going to sleep at night. So watch for the handouts and please help them practice. Once they are in the habit of relaxing, they will recognize, in the moment, when they are tense and stressed and will automatically go into relaxation mode. If they have not practiced ... it's anybody's guess what will happen when they need it!

I also want to make you aware that we will be moving the 3rd - 5th grade Career Fair to March 24th instead of Feb. 3rd, and we are still looking for more volunteers!
