Thursday, November 11, 2021 at 5:00 p.m.

- CALL TO ORDER The Dolores School Board work session was called to order at 5:00 pm on November 11, 2021.
- II. ROLL CALL Members present were: Maegan Crowley, Casey McClellan, Lenetta Shull.
 QUORUM was present. Also present: Superintendent Reece Blincoe, District Secretary Laurie Arnett.

III. WORK SESSION

A. Continuance of policy review for June 2021 policies – presentation of information

The Board continued their first reading of policies.

The Board discussed removing specific COVID-19-related language in the new policy changes to JLCB and JLCB-R and replacing it with "any significant health concerns" so that policies will not then have to be changed again in the future. With those changes, the Board approved the updated policy.

They then discussed the language in policy JLCB regarding required immunizations and exemptions, and policies JLCD, JLCD-R, and JLCD-E, governing various aspects of administration of medication to students. District Secretary Laurie Arnett guided the Board members through the changes and requirements.

The Board discussed policies JLCDB and JLCDB-E. The two options for JLCDB-E allow for either a volunteer district personnel to administer, or the primary caregiver to administer medical marijuana. The Board discussed keeping both options, and adding the language that the primary caregiver should administer except if a life-threatening situation arises. The district nurse will be consulted for her recommendations on updates to the policy to cover these situations, and any other suggestions she has. In the meantime, these policies will be removed from the consent agenda at the regular board meeting.

Superintendent Blincoe told the Board that our policy audit has been completed by CASB, and that there are over 100 policies on our books that are no longer policies so can be removed, and there are roughly 70 policies that need review. In addition, there are 29 policies already slated for first reading review. The Board discussed how to tackle this, and will begin reviewing the next batch as soon as they are sent out by the district office.
