--**Dyslexia screener** : <u>https://www.lexercise.com</u> This is just to give you an idea if your child might be struggling with Dyslexia. Remember it is not a diagnosis.

-Check out all the articles and resources on the **International Dyslexia Association (IDA)** website: <u>https://dyslexiaida.org/</u> (FREE).

--There's a cerebellar stimulation program (dyslexia is underactivity on the front middle and back of the left side of the brain - this stimulates the back portion) called **Learning Breakthrough** that has been recommended by some pretty reputable experts. It can take the edge off. It is best to treat it like a mission and do it morning and night for about 3 - 6 months straight. 6 is better. <u>https://learningbreakthrough.com/</u> (\$500 - \$600 one time cost)

--**Fast ForWord.** This is a computer program that is multi-sensory. It was created by Dr. Michael Merzenich – the father of neuroplasticity. It has been shown to reactivate all 3 areas of the brain that are usually underactive in Dyslexia. They have brain scans to show the improvements. I don't know about and can't recommend anything else they are selling. <u>https://www.scilearn.com/</u> (\$1500 + They will work out reasonable monthly payment plans)

--Brain HQ is an app by the same Dr. Merzenich. It's for older teens and adults, but younger students can do it with supervision. Needs to be done daily, faithfully, for 3-6 months - 6 to be sure. (about \$14 per month or \$96 per year. Younger students will need supervision to stay on task).

--**Liberty School i**n Durango is specifically for Dyslexic kids - They do hold summer programs that might be useful and affordable and for \$550 parents can get trained yourself in the Orton Gillingham method which is approved by the IDA. It has the same effectiveness as Fast Forword but you would do all the work. (You'd also be qualified to tutor which is a HUGE need for this area if you were ever interested). https://www.thelibertyschool.org/community-programs
