



Job Posting: Certified Athletic Trainer

Position Overview:

Dolores School District is seeking a **Certified Athletic Trainer** to serve the district and ensure the health and well-being of student-athletes. This position will be two days per week in Dolores, with coverage at home contests for the school. We are looking for a dedicated professional to support our student-athletes in injury prevention, rehabilitation, and game-day readiness.

Responsibilities:

- **Injury Prevention & Rehabilitation:** Work with student-athletes to prevent injuries and assist in the rehabilitation process.
- **Game-Day Coverage:** Be present at home contests for Dolores High Schools, providing on-site care as needed.
- **Athletic Training Room Management:** Maintain and stock the facilities with necessary equipment and supplies. Keep the facilities clean and organized and ensure that all traveling teams have a medical kit when they compete away from the school.
- **Medical Liaison:** Communicate with medical professionals regarding student-athlete injuries and needed medical care.
- **Concussion Evaluation & Protocols:** Assess possible concussions and enforce state, CHSAA, and school district return-to-play protocols.
- **Certification:** Maintain state licensure, as appropriate
- **Team Player:** Collaborate with coaches to ensure proper training practices as well as keeping coaches informed regarding athletes readiness to participate or not
- **Staff Communication:** Due to the varying schedules of school, it may be necessary to adjust the schedule accordingly. Clear and consistent communication about any schedule changes is a crucial part of this role.
- **Parent/Athlete Communication:** Be an active participant in communicating the injuries and treatment options with both athletes and their parents/guardians.

- **General Athletic Training Duties:** Perform all other responsibilities typically expected of a high school athletic trainer.
