School Attorney/Legal Services

The school district attorney shall be directly responsible to the Board of Education but shall work cooperatively with the superintendent of schools and others designated by the Board or the superintendent. The school district attorney shall:

- 1. Advise the Board of the legal implications of district issues, concerns and contemplated decisions.
- 2. Give legal counsel and guidance during school bonding and building programs.
- 3. Furnish such legal advice and support as the Board or the superintendent may request.

The school attorney shall be appointed by the Board and associated fees shall be approved by the Board.
