Attendance Policy Changes

High School - After students miss 20% of the school days (excused or unexcused)

for the term they will have to make up the hours missed at a rate of 1 hour for every

hour missed in order to earn credit for courses that were successfully completed

with a grade of 60% or higher. If the hours are not made up prior to the start of the

next school year the course(s) will remain coded on the student transcript as NC

(No Credit).

Middle School - Students that miss 20% or more of the school days for the school

year will be referred to the building leadership team for possible retention, summer

school or alternative academic interventions.

Elementary School - Students that miss 20% or more of the school days for the

school year will be referred to the building leadership team for possible retention,

summer school or alternative academic interventions.

Out of District Students

Students who miss 20% of the school days for the year or more may not be

readmitted for the following school year.

Out of district students who wish to enroll in the Dolores School District may not be

admitted if they have had an absenteeism rate of 20% or more.
